

Multiplication Conquest

What you need

- ❖ A Multiplication conquest sheet.
- ❖ 2 pencil crayons of different colours
- ❖ 2 dice.



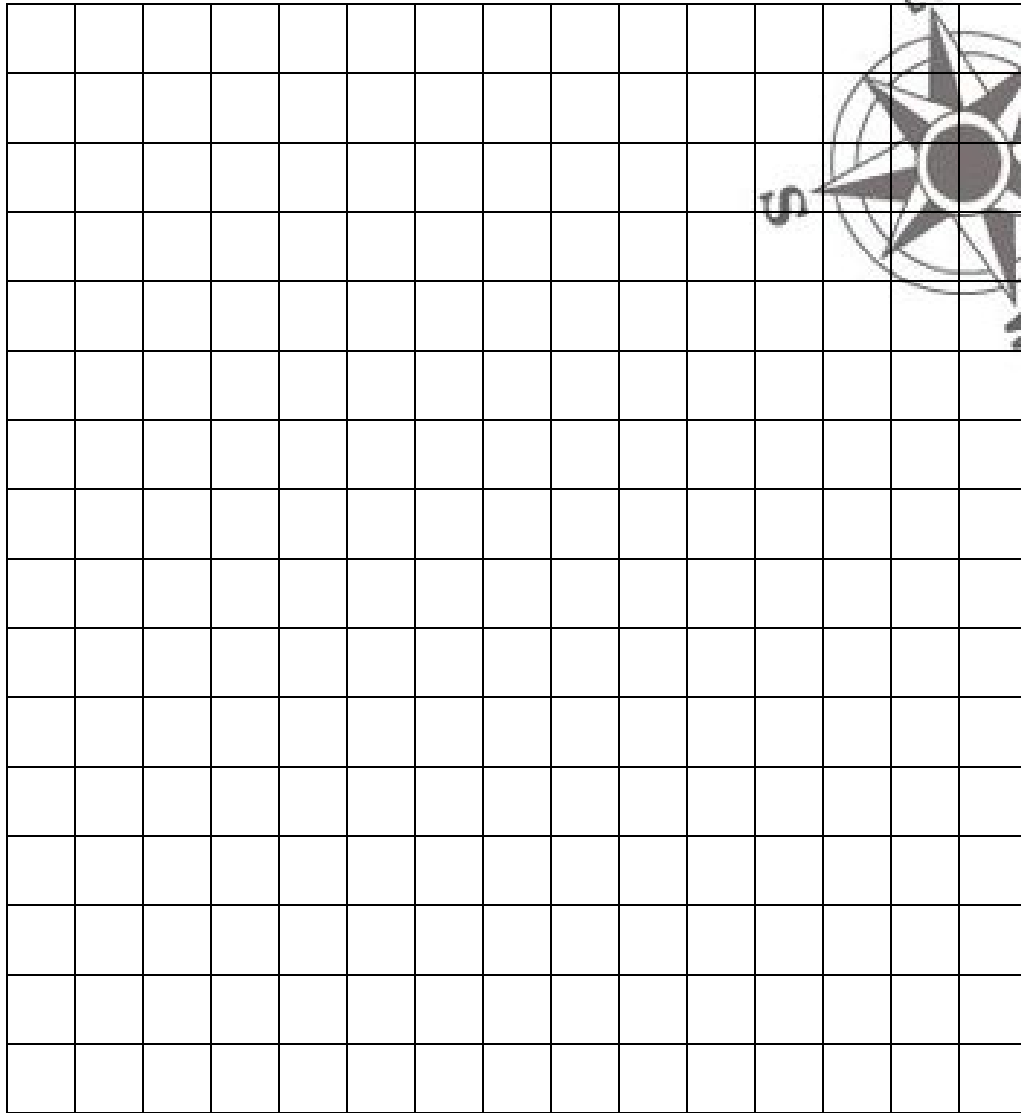
Rules:

- ❖ Players each roll one die. The player with the highest roll goes first.
- ❖ The first player rolls the dice. The player then uses the one die as the length and the other die as the width and colors in the area. So if a player rolls a 2 and a three they would color in an area that is 2×3 for a total of 6 squares.
- ❖ It is then the next players turn and they follow the same process.
- ❖ If a player rolls the dice and there is not a big enough space to color in their area they get one strike. They colour in one of their strikes and pass the dice to the other player.
- ❖ The game end when all squares are colored in or a player has 3 strikes.

Winning the game:

- ❖ The winner is the person who has the most squares coloured in.
